Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) is a leadership development program sponsored by Rotary. At RYLA, over 120 high school students (grades 9th-11th) from Michigan and southwest Ontario come together with Rotarians for a 3-day camp and participate in presentations, activities, and workshops. Some of the topics covered during this weekend include: leadership fundamentals and ethics; communication skills, problem solving and conflict management; and community and global citizenship.

Activities at RYLA include team building activities such as high ropes courses, giant swing, and zip lines, as well as group exercises that promote & define leadership, ethics, problem solving, communications, and citizenship.
